## UIW vice president to address chamber

The vice president for administration at the University of the Incarnate Word will address the chamber at its luncheon Wednesday, October 6, at Water Street Oyster Bar.

Dr. David M. Jurenovich came to the University (formerly The College) in June 1988, from Gannon University in Erie, Pa., where he served as the Director for Student Affairs and Services.

In his first year at Incarnate Word he served as the Dean for Student Affairs and Services. During his tenure as the dean, he instituted many changes to enhance student facilities and services including changing the food service and student activity areas, establishing a full time campus security/safety department that has now evolved into a licensed campus police force.

Dr. Jurenovich developed the University Student Athletic program/facilities to include 16 sports for men and women, a renovated University Wellness Center, the construction of the Alice P. McDermott Convocation Center and most recently the new Ann Barshop Natatorium.

Dr. Jurenovich was constantly looking for ways to improve the

University's efficiency, effectiveness and overall customer service while meeting the needs of a growing and diverse student body.

In August 1989, Dr. Jurenovich was promoted to Vice President for Planning & Marketing. In his role as Vice President, he was responsible for the departments of Athletics, Financial Assistance, Recruitment and Enrollment Services, Public Relations & Marketing, Administrative Computing, Institutional Research, Instructional Technology, the Wellness center/Intramurals Department and the International Initiatives Department.

During this time the overall enrollment of the University more than tripled, the on-campus student life facilities doubled and the financial assistance programs grew from just over \$400,000 in 1998 to over \$8 million today.

Assisting President Agnese in the initial planning of the China Incarnate Word Initiative, he was responsible for developing the initial campus plan for this new site venture in Guangzhou, China. During this period he was also responsible for brokering all contractual arrangements involving the telecommunications and technology

tual arrangements involving the telecommunications and technology that led to the implementation of the new campus administrative operating system (Banner/ SCT), the IBM ThinkPad laptop agreement/program and the wireless campus concept.

In June of 1999, Dr. Jurenovich was promoted to Vice President for Administration. Dr. Jurenovich currently oversees eight departments with approximately 90 employees. His primary role as the Vice President for Administration is to ensure that each of these departments functions in accordance with the University Mission and Vision.

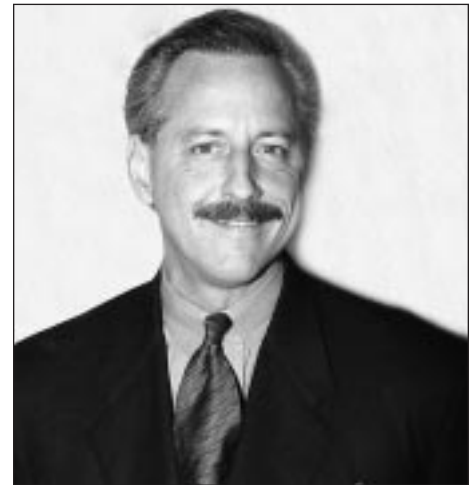
In addition, he is the chairperson of the University Planning Commission, the primary vehicle for the University's strategic and annual planning and decision-making processes, entailing the University initiatives as well as those of Incarnate Word High School and St. Anthony Catholic High School, also operated by Incarnate Word.

Dr. Jurenovich has also served on the United Way Stewardship and Program Review Board for the past four years, and is

the campus coordinator of the Annual Incarnate Word United Way Employee Campaign. In addition he serves on the San Antonio Rotary, the Board of the Witte Museum, along with the Water Resource Advising Committee, and has been recently selected for the Board of the North San Antonio Chamber of Commerce.

Dr. Jurenovich was awarded the distinction of Distinguished Professor. In 2000, he was the recipient of the American Advertising Federation P.R.O.F. award for excellence in advertising and marketing in support of higher education and teaching. He serves as an adjunct professor with emphasis in the University Wellness & Psychology departments.

Along with his PhD., Dr. Jurenovich holds an M.B.A. in Organizational Psychology and a M.S. in counseling in higher education. Dr. Jurenovich is a licensed professional counselor in family counseling, and serves as a student advisor for psychology majors at the University. He teaches in the University undergraduate and ADCaP (Adult Degree Completion Program) serving as an adjunct professor in

courses ranging from International Business, Consumer Behavior, Sales Management, Service Marketing, Organizational Behavior and Wellness. He was nominated to the Who's Who Among American Teachers in 1996 and 1998.

His greatest accomplishment and joy, he says was not achieved alone, but with his wife, Elizabeth's help, that being the birth of his two sons, two-year-old Christian Michael, and one-year-old, Matthew David.
